- Objective: *“[...] developing the various aspects of crime prevention at the union level [...], and shall support crime prevention activities at the national and local level”*
- Target groups:
 - Practitioners and policymakers at both local and national levels
 - EU and international agencies, organisations, working groups

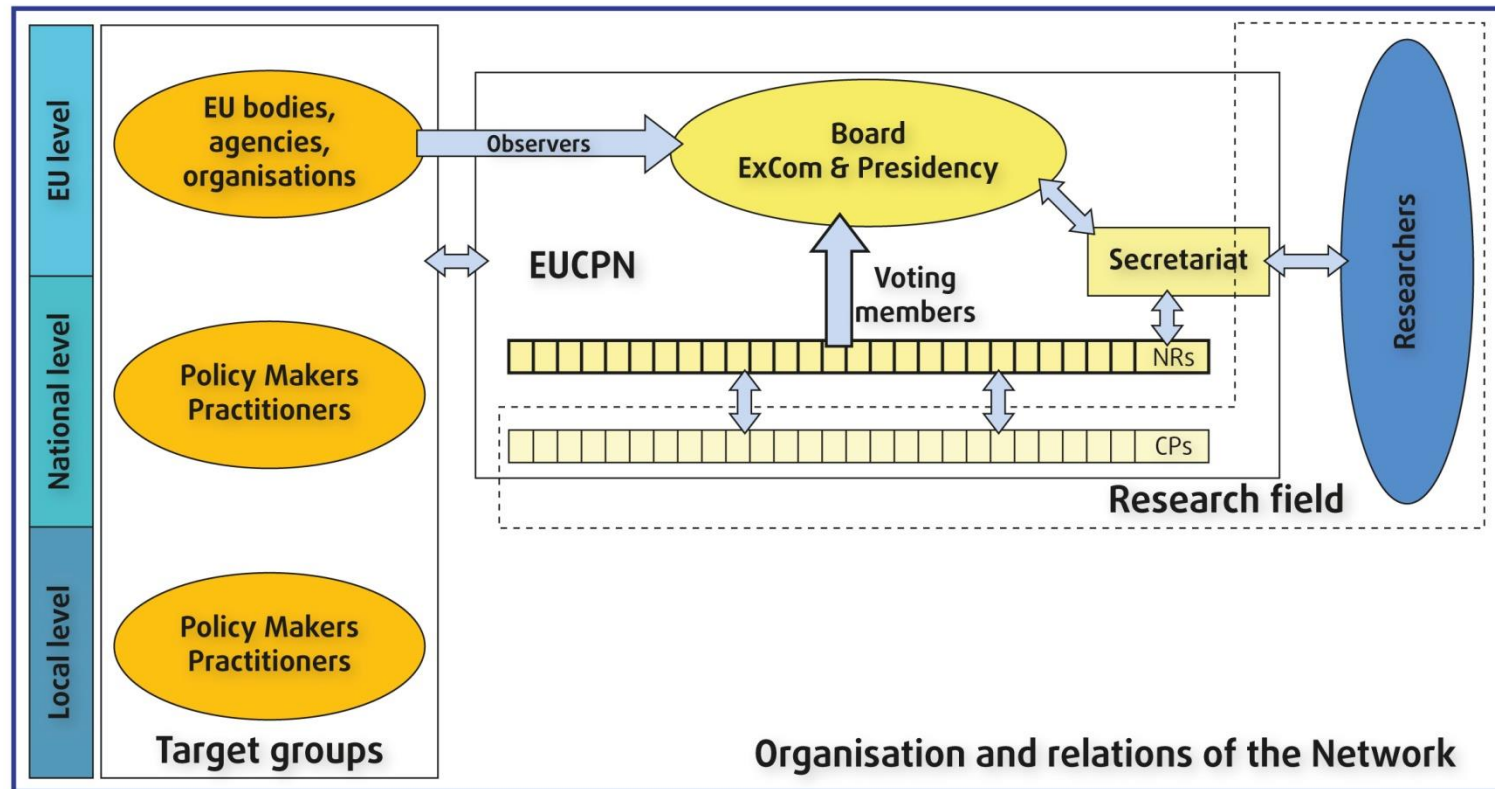

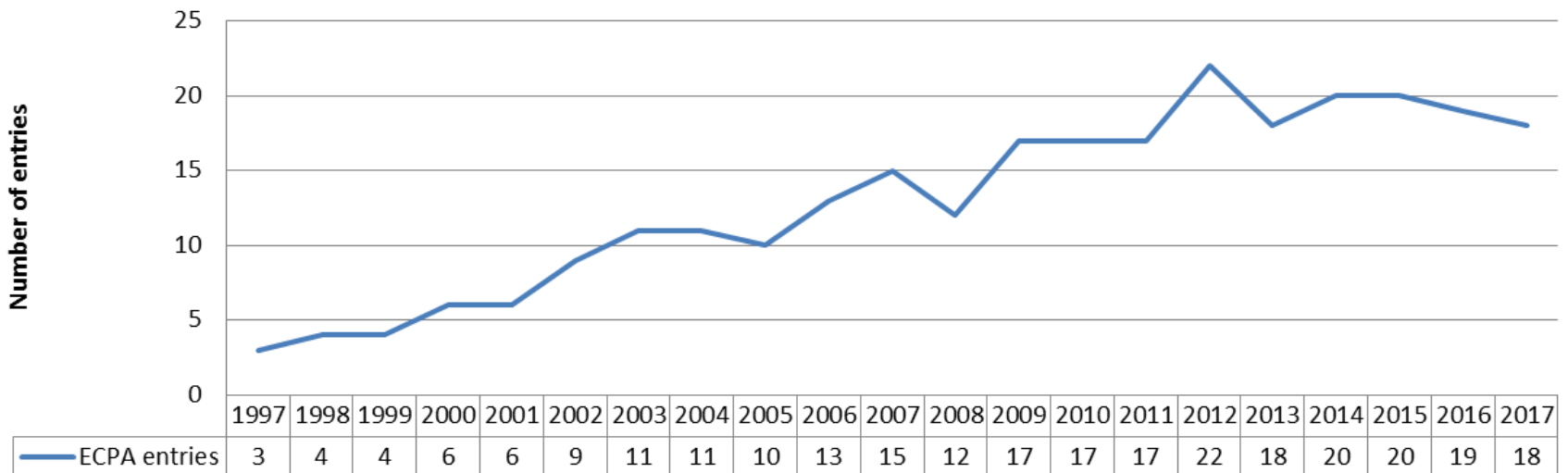

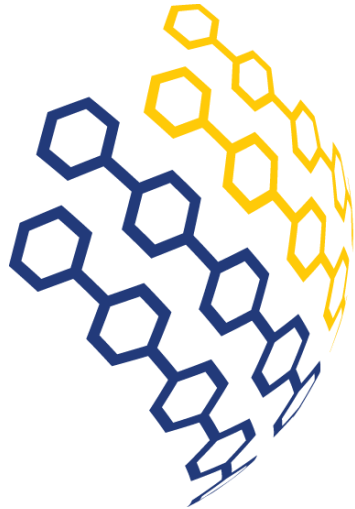
